Đana Kahriman was born in 1989 in Dubrovnik. She begins her music education at the Luka Sorkočević Art School, in the class of prof. Ivančica Kalanj. She graduated in 2011 at the Music Academy in Zagreb, in the class of prof. Leonid Sorokow.

During her schooling she won numerous awards at national and international competitions.

She has performed as a soloist with orchestras such as the Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra, Sarajevo Philharmonic, Kaunas Philharmonic, Zagreb Philharmonic, HRT Symphony Orchestra, Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, HGM String Orchestra, Zadar Chamber Orchestra and Zagreb Soloists.

As a soloist and chamber musician, she performs at the Dubrovnik Summer Festival, the Osor Music Evenings, the Samobor Music Autumn, the Music Evenings in St. Donat, the Festival of Croatian Music in Vienna, the Franjo Krežma Memorial, the Amadeo Music Stage, the Music Biennale, the Dubrovnik Late Summer Festivals and the Stradun Classic.

She improved her skills at seminars of eminent pedagogues such as Leonid Sorokow, Marina Sorokowa, Goran Končar, Grigory Zhislin, Zakhar Bron, Boris Kuschnir, Viktor Tretyakov.

She works as a chamber musician in the pierrot ensemble Glazbena staza and the quartet of the Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra.

Đana is the winner of the Stjepan Šulek and Ivo Dražinić award.

Since 2011 she has been a member of the Zagreb Soloists, and since 2015 she has been the concert master of the Dubrovnik Symphony Orchestra.
